We are excited to share the **Spring 2026 after-school clubs** at Lee! This page will be your one stop for everything club related this semester.

This catalog now includes both vendor-led clubs and Lee teacher-led clubs for Spring 2026.

Start and end dates and meeting times vary by club, so please read each listing carefully to make sure it works for your student and your family's schedule.

A few quick things to know:

- **Two types of clubs:**
 - Vendor clubs on campus (run and managed by outside providers)
 - Teacher-led clubs (organized by Lee staff, coming in the next update)
- **Registration and payment:**

For vendor clubs, caregivers sign up and pay **directly with the vendor** using the links in each listing. Please contact the vendor or instructor, not the Lee front office or admin team, with program questions.
- **Scholarships:**

Many clubs offer full or partial scholarships. For **vendor-led clubs**, caregivers should reach out **directly to the club vendor** using the contact information in each listing. For **teacher-led clubs**, scholarship requests can go through our school counselor, **Cheyenne Koerth**, at cheyenne.koerth@austinisd.org.
- **Enrollment limits:**

Each club has its own minimum and maximum number of students, set by the provider. If a club does not meet its minimum, the provider may cancel the club and will work with caregivers directly about refunds or credits.
- **Important reminder:**

After School Enrichment Clubs are meant to be fun extras for students. They are **enrichment**, not childcare. Vendors and instructors are responsible for communicating any schedule changes or cancellations to caregivers.

In this course, students use Scratch to design and build their own games and interactive projects. They learn coding concepts such as variables, conditionals and loops while planning levels, debugging and improving their designs. The class combines guided lessons with plenty of hands-on coding time.

Limited scholarships are available, typically one full or two 50 percent scholarships with sufficient enrollment. Caregivers can follow the provider's instructions to register an account, add a student and request scholarship enrollment.

In the Friday Gardening and Nature Exploration Club, students tend our campus gardens and explore the natural world around Lee. Each week includes hands-on gardening tasks, such as planting seeds, caring for veggies and observing insects, along with age appropriate conversations about healthy foods, ecosystems and caring for our environment. The club builds responsibility, curiosity and a sense of pride in keeping our school green and growing.

1. Browse options by day and grade.

Review this catalog by **day of the week** and **grade level** to find clubs that fit your student's interests.

2. Double check dates and times.

Start and end **dates** and **start and end times** vary by club. Please read each listing carefully to be sure the schedule works for your family and that your student meets any prerequisites (for example, biking ability or grade level).

3. Register directly with the provider.

Use each club's **registration link or instructions** listed above to sign up directly with the vendor or instructor.

4. Direct program questions to the club.

For questions about **curriculum, cost, scholarships, cancellations or make up classes**, please contact the **club vendor or instructor** directly.

Important Notes

- **Club enrollment:**

Clubs may be canceled or combined if minimum enrollment is not met. Minimum and maximum enrollment numbers are set by each provider.

- **Policies:**

Vendors set their own **refund, behavior and late pick up policies**. Please review those carefully when you register.

- **No-school days:**

Clubs do not meet on AISD student holidays or campus closure days. Vendors will confirm any skipped dates and make up plans in their own communications.

- **Scholarships and discounts:**

Some clubs offer scholarships, sibling discounts or staff discounts. All clubs are paid for by caregivers. For **vendor clubs**, please contact the **vendor or instructor directly** about any scholarship or discount options. For **teacher-led clubs**, scholarship support is coordinated through our school counselor, **Cheyenne Koerth**. Please note: Vendor-led clubs are hosted at Lee Elementary but are not affiliated with or managed by the Lee PTA or Lee Elementary School. The PTA's role is to help connect caregivers with enrichment providers. All payments, logistics and communications are handled directly between caregivers and club vendors or instructors. The PTA and school do not oversee operations or receive any portion of club fees. After School Enrichment Clubs are extracurricular opportunities, not childcare.
